MLSHF Vision Screening Program Resources for Lions Clubs

Maine Lions/Kid Sight USA Vision Screening Committee is available to help clubs who are interested in doing vision screening. They will match screening clubs willing to mentor with clubs that are interested in learning more about the vision screening process.

A Vision screening event only requires 2-3 Lions. It can often be completed in a couple of hours. It is a rewarding service project that does not require a great deal of time or heavy lifting! You can view the Vision Screening Manual on www.MaineLions.org. It documents the steps for your club to successfully complete this project. It includes instructions, sample letters and forms, and tips for a successful screening.

Vision Screening also offers an opportunity for Lions Clubs to let young parents know who we are and what we do for our community.
